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Norfolk Naval Station gets three new eateries

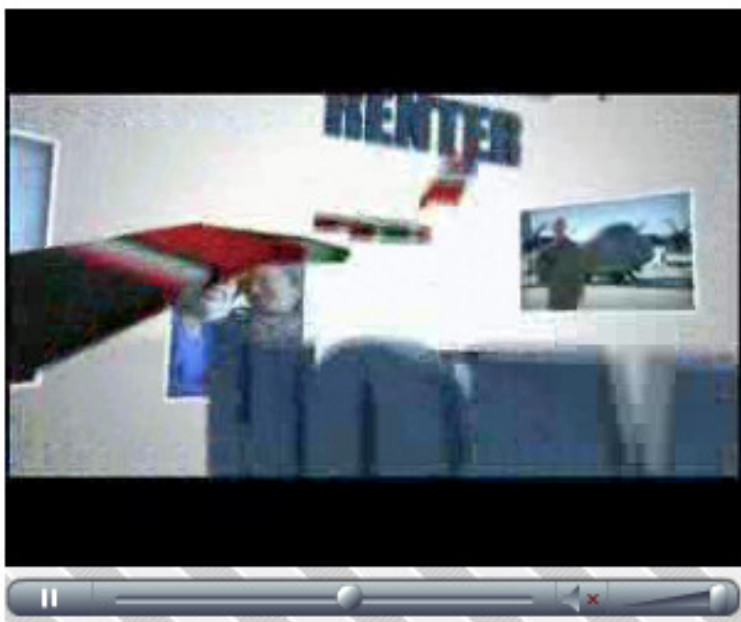

Naval Station Norfolk will have three new food options with the grand opening of Tim Hortons, Cold Stone Creamery and Great Steak on Thursday.

The 4,500-square-foot "tri-brand restaurant" opened as part of a partnership between Kahala, parent company of Cold Stone Creamery and Great Steak, and Tim Hortons Inc. that began in 2009.

Tim Hortons, which serves coffee, fresh baked goods and has a lunch menu, also has a location at Fort Knox. Kahala has similar operations on 18 military bases worldwide and in the Pentagon, but the location in Norfolk will be the company's first time working with Naval Exchange Services.

The eateries will be open daily from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m., according to a news release from the Naval Station Norfolk.
